

Code of Conduct

For Parents, Coaches and Spectators

Parent Behavior

Do not use abusive language before, during or after athletic events.

This is not a good look for St. Clare and your children see that and mimic this behavior.

We need to also promote good sportsmanship.

Officials

Parents, coaches and spectators must treat all officials with respect and refrain from criticizing officials.

24 Hour Rule

Parents must follow the 24 hour rule.

This states no discussion with the coach or emails about something you disagree with until 24 hours after the athletic event.

This is very helpful in putting a lot of things in perspective when given some time to think on it.

Breaking 24 hour rule

If any parent breaks the 24 hour rule that parent will need to meet with the Athletic Director and Principal at their convenience.

Athletes will not be allowed to play until that meeting has taken place and a resolution has been met.

2nd time the rule is broken parent and athlete will have to sit out 3 games.

3rd time the rule is broken parent and athlete will have to sit out the rest of the season.

Ejections

Any parent, coach or spectator ejected from a home or away game will receive a one game suspension.

Two ejections during the school year will result in an automatic suspension for the remainder of year.

Who to talk to and when

After waiting 24 hours please contact the coach first if you have an issue.

If you feel you need more information please contact the Athletic Director.

If you would like more information please contact the principal after you have already reached out to the Athletic Director and Coach first.

Failure to follow these guidelines will result in disciplinary action.
